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Executive Summary

This report presents an overview of the services provided under **Work Package 5 (WP5)** during the **second year** (M12-M24) of the **EDIH Madrid Region** project, focusing on digital transformation support for small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs). The services aim to enhance SMEs' capabilities by facilitating access to funding opportunities and supporting the submission of project proposals, thus improving their competitiveness, innovation capacity and market presence.

The **EDIH Madrid Region** project is designed to accelerate the digital transformation of SMEs and public sector organizations through:

- Digital Maturity Assessments
- Training and skill development services
- Support for securing financial resources for digital transformation

The primary beneficiaries of WP5 include SMEs in manufacturing, Industry 4.0, service sectors, and mobility and transport, ensuring they receive tailored guidance in securing regional, national, and European funding to adopt innovative digital technologies.

During the second year of implementation, WP5 delivered a total of **227 services**, including:

- **211 services for funding opportunity identification**
- **32 services for project proposal submissions**

These services were facilitated by a consortium of key partners, including **IDConsortium, AEDHE, AECIM, Hewlett-Packard Servicios España, Fundación Madrimasd, Universidad Carlos III de Madrid, EIT Digital, and others**, ensuring a comprehensive and expert-led approach to digital transformation support.

The main **achievements and impact** generated from the provision of the services reach:

- **169 SMEs** received direct support, with **48 SMEs engaging in multiple services**.
- SMEs in the **manufacturing and processing sector** represented the largest segment of beneficiaries (**65 SMEs**).
- The support services led to **€4.7 million in public funding secured** for SME digitalization initiatives.

KPIs achievement include:

- **211 SMEs** supported in **funding search**.
- **32 project proposals submitted**.
- **€4.7M additional investment triggered**.

These KPIs were achieved due to several measures implemented to maximize service effectiveness, such as:

- **Customized financial roadmaps** based on SME needs and priorities.
- **Workshops and information sessions** to enhance funding awareness.
- **Strategic consortium-building efforts** to strengthen EU project applications.
- **Hands-on proposal development and compliance support**.

The services provided under WP5 have had a **substantial impact on SME digitalization**,

strengthening their financial capacity to adopt advanced technologies and innovative business models. The **EDIH Madrid Region** has proven to be a critical facilitator in guiding SMEs through complex funding landscapes and proposal development processes. Moving forward, efforts will continue to expand outreach, refine service delivery, and increase the **success rate of funding applications**, aligning with both **regional and European digital transformation strategies**.

This report underscores the continued commitment of the **EDIH Madrid Region** to foster a digitally advanced and competitive SME ecosystem, ensuring sustainable growth and innovation in the coming years.

1. INTRODUCTION

The EDIH MADRID REGION project aims to establish a European Digital Innovation Hub (EDIH) in the Madrid region, targeting the digitization of both the public sector and small to medium-sized enterprises (SMEs).

The primary objectives of the project of EDIH MADRID REGION include:

- Accelerating the digital transformation of SMEs and public sector organizations in the Madrid region.
- Providing comprehensive support services, including digital maturity assessments, skill and training services, and support for accessing financing for digital transformation.
- Facilitating the integration and adaptation of advanced digital technologies to improve operational efficiencies and business models.

The project encompasses several key sectors, specifically:

- SMEs in the service sector.
- Industrial SMEs focusing on Industry 4.0.
- Regional and municipal public administrations.
- Mobility and transport sectors.

The project commenced on December 1, 2022, and is set to run for 36 months. This timeline includes various phases of implementation, monitoring, and evaluation to ensure the project meets its objectives and delivers tangible benefits to its stakeholders.

This deliverable contains a detailed description of the services provided by the EDIH Madrid Region within its second year of activity for the Support to find investments service, delivered within WP5.

The EDIH MADRID REGION project places a significant emphasis on the digital transformation of industrial SMEs, particularly through support in securing funding and strategic assistance in the preparation of project proposals aimed at fostering digital innovation. This service facilitates access to public and private financial resources that enable SMEs to implement advanced digital technologies, enhance operational efficiency and develop new digital-driven products and services.

The service is delivered through a consortium of key partners, ensuring expertise in both financials.

This report evaluates the effectiveness and efficiency of the services delivered in WP 5.

Effectiveness refers to the extent to which the services delivered achieve the intended outcomes and goals. For the EDIH MADRID REGION project, effectiveness can be measured through several key indicators: Digital transformation success, skill development, innovation and growth (impact on competitiveness (enable the SMEs to better compete in the market)

Efficiency relates to the resources used to deliver the services and the speed and cost-effectiveness of the delivery process. Key factors include resources utilization (human, technological resources to deliver high quality services); timelines (delivery of the services with the planned timelines); services delivery processes (by reducing bureaucracy and improving speed); scalability (ability to scale services to accommodate more services without increasing costs or time)

By focusing on these aspects, the EDIH MADRID REGION project aims to ensure that the services provided are both effective in achieving their intended goals and efficient in their delivery, maximizing the benefits for all stakeholders involved.

2.DESCRPTION OF THE SERVICES PROVIDED IN WP5: SUPPORT TO FIND INVESTMENTS

The **Support to Find Investments** service within the **EDIH Madrid Region** project is designed to assist SMEs in securing funding for their **digital transformation**. This service is part of **WP5 - Funding and Finance Services** and aims to enhance the financial capabilities of SMEs by facilitating access to both public and private investment opportunities. The service is divided into a) Support in looking for funding opportunities; b) Support in the submission of project proposals. These sub-services address the financial barriers that SMEs face, providing the necessary financial advisory and strategic guidance to access funding opportunities that enable their digital transformation.

Key activities of the Support to Find Investments service include:

A) Support in looking for funding opportunities:

Based on the information collected in the Digital Maturity Assessment (DMA) and the tailored Action Plan developed for the SMEs, an initial assessment meeting is conducted with the SME. The aim of this introductory meeting is to perform an in-depth analysis of the SME's funding needs.

Under a structured approach, the SME's profile, digitalization priorities, investment capacity and long-term business objectives are carefully evaluated. This analysis enables the identification of the most suitable funding schemes at regional, national and European levels, as well as private funding opportunities, aligning them with the company's technological roadmap and strategic growth plans.

The service explores a diverse range of financing instruments, including grants, public funding programs, venture capital, private investors and corporate innovation funds, ensuring a tailored approach to each SME's financial requirements.

Following this assessment, a customized funding roadmap is developed, outlining the available financing opportunities, their eligibility criteria, application requirements, key deadlines and expected outcomes. This roadmap serves as a strategic guide, ensuring that the SME is well-prepared to navigate the funding landscape and maximize its chances of securing both public and private financial support for digital transformation initiatives.

B) Support in the Submission of Project Proposals:

Once the most suitable funding opportunity has been identified and aligned with the SME's digitalization strategy, the next step is to **translate this opportunity into a strong and competitive project proposal**. Building on the insights gained from the funding assessment, the

Support in the Submission of Project Proposals service ensures that SMEs receive the necessary guidance to develop a well-structured, compelling and compliant proposal, maximizing their chances of securing financial support.

Under a structured approach, the SME's project concept, technological objectives, expected impact, and resource requirements are carefully analyzed to tailor the proposal to the specific funding scheme. The service includes:

- Strategic alignment: Ensuring that the project fits the priorities and evaluation criteria of the chosen funding program, whether at the regional, national, European, or private level.
- Proposal structuring and content development: Assisting in defining clear objectives, expected outcomes, work plan, budget, and key performance indicators.
- Consortium building and partnerships (if needed): Identifying potential collaborators, research institutions or industry partners to strengthen the proposal.
- Compliance check: Reviewing the proposal to ensure it meets formal and technical requirements, improving the chances of approval.

Throughout the process, SMEs receive personalized support in preparing high-quality submissions, maximizing their likelihood of securing financial resources for digital transformation projects. The goal is to empower SMEs to successfully navigate complex funding procedures, positioning them for sustainable growth, innovation, and competitiveness.

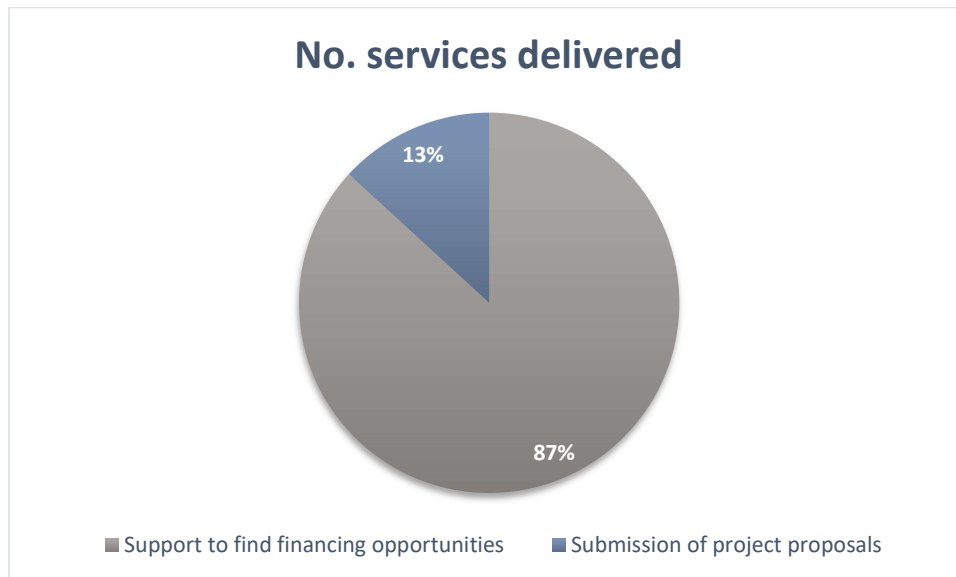

3. ANALYSIS OF THE SERVICES DELIVERED

Under the Support to Find Investment service, delivered under WP5, a total of 243 services were provided to SMEs, being 211 related to the support in looking to financing opportunities and 32 for the submission of project proposals.

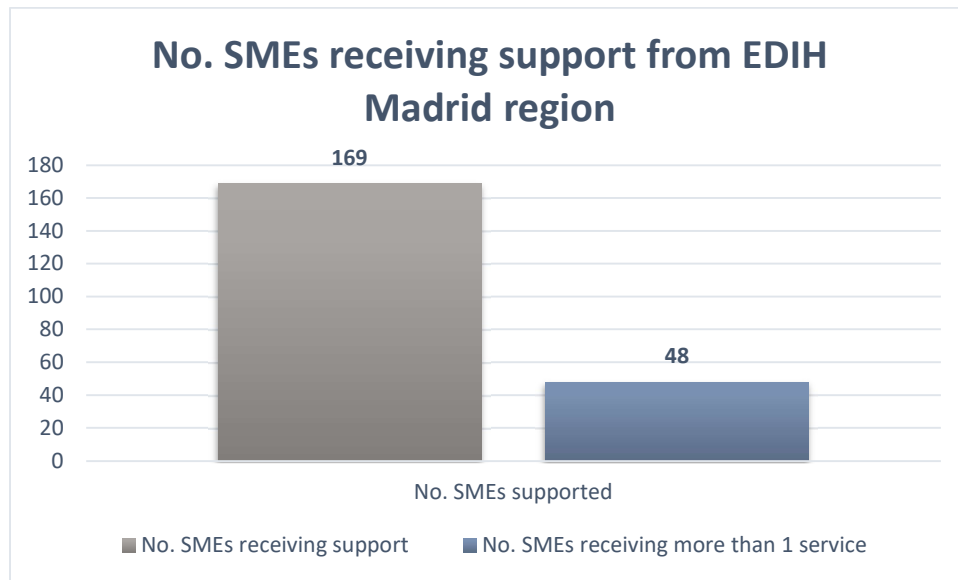

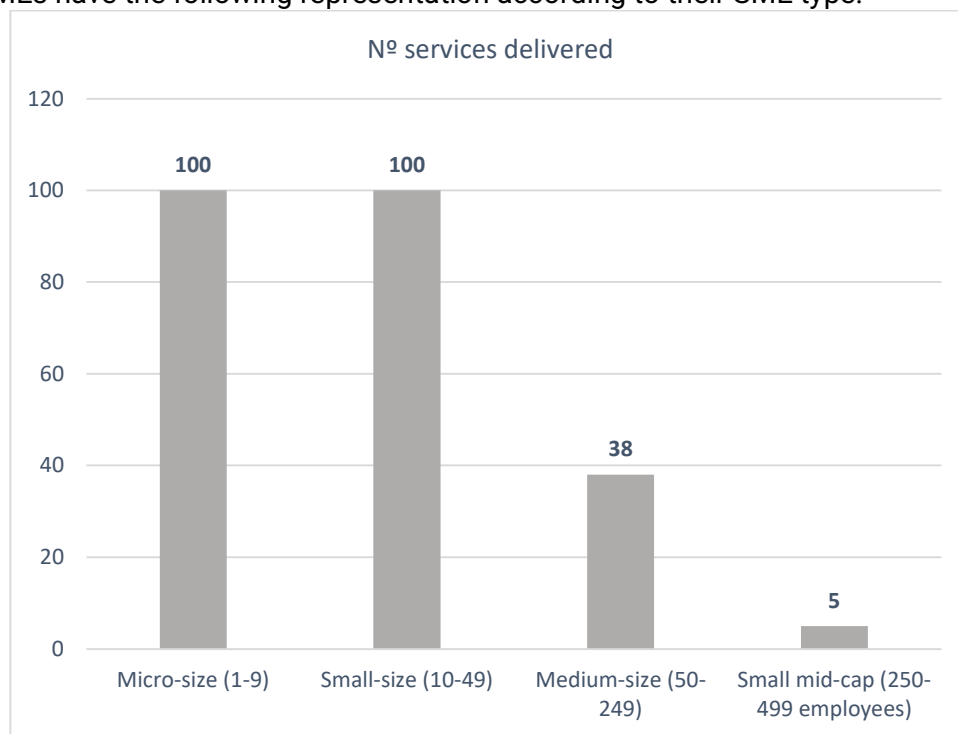

service.

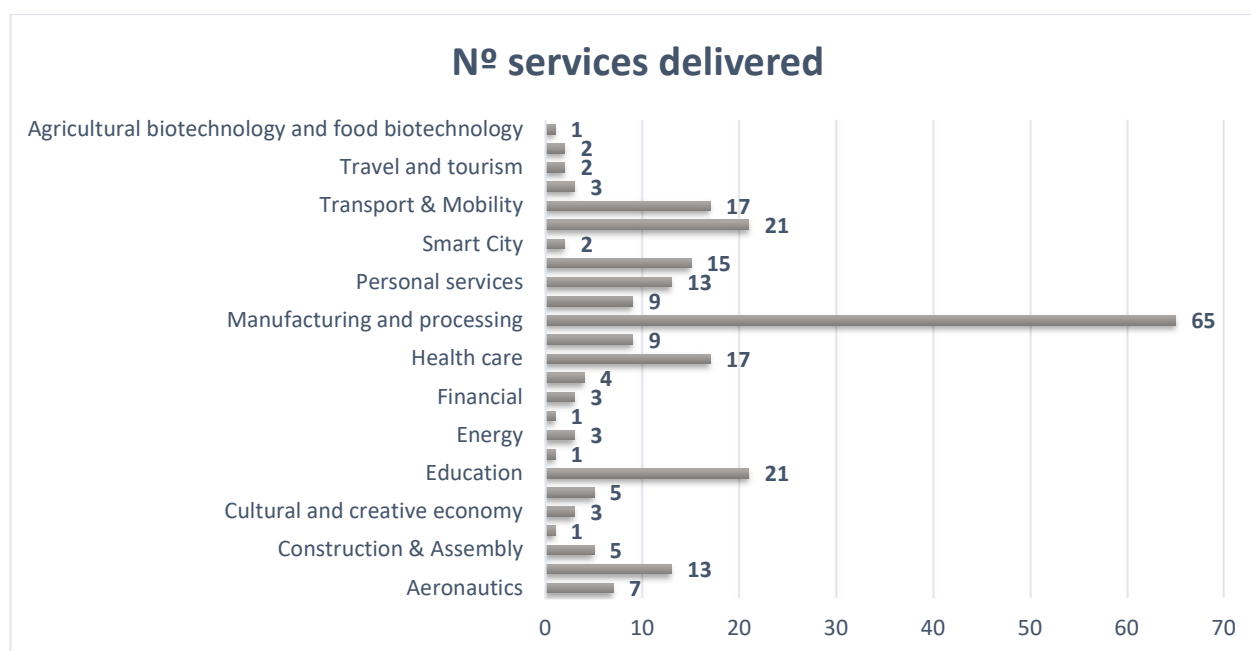


These SMEs have the following representation according to their SME type:



As it is seen, the majority of the SMEs that receive the service are micro and small SMEs.

Segmenting the services delivered by the type of industrial sector where the SMEs belong to, the graphic representation is the following:



As it is seen, the SMEs with more representation that received support to find investments come from the Manufacturing and processing industrial sector (65 SMEs).

Besides the number of SMEs supported and the number of services delivered to these SMEs for the digitalization of their businesses, having impact in the market uptake of innovative products and services as well as improved processes, tools and methodologies and business models, the Support to Find Investments services generated impact in terms of income. In this regard, the amount of investment triggered by the services delivered during the second year of the project, reached a total of **4.734.729,49 €** public funding received by the supported SMEs.

The reported figures indicate progress toward achieving the project's defined KPIs, despite being highly ambitious. So far, the primary focus has been to engage as many companies as possible in utilizing the services offered by EDIH Madrid Region. Despite the ambitious targets set, the continued engagement of some companies highlights their satisfaction with the services provided.

4. BEST PRACTICES AND CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

To ensure the effective delivery of services to SMEs by the Digital European Innovation Hub Madrid Region, below there are a series of best practices that have triggered the delivery of high-value, impactful services to SMEs, effectively supporting their digital transformation and access to funding.

Support to Find Investments:

A) Support to find financing opportunities:

- Conducting information sessions, webinars and personalized consultations to raise awareness of available funding opportunities and encourage SME participation.
- Conduct comprehensive diagnostics with the customers to understand their interests and funding needs as well as their capacity to participate in national and European funding calls.
- Customize financing strategies according to the SMEs' business goals, ensuring that funding sources and project proposals match their digital transformation needs and strategic priorities.
- Regularly update SMEs on relevant calls for proposals.
- Highlight previous success stories of SMEs that have secured funding through similar programs. Sharing these examples can inspire confidence and serve as practical references for other SMEs.

Support in the submission of project proposals to EU programs:

- Providing structured guidance and workshops to help SMEs strengthen their applications and increase their chances of securing funding.
- Foster SMEs participation in consortiums: Encourage SMEs to explore consortium opportunities by facilitating connections between businesses with complementary goals and digital challenges.
- Provide SMEs with guidance on the entire proposal submission process, from understanding call criteria to ensuring compliance with guidelines and deadlines.
- Provide practical support in proposal writing by offering hands-on assistance in writing and reviewing proposals to ensure alignment with EU programs or national calls, highlighting how their projects meet eligibility and impact criteria.
- Support SMEs in creating feasible project budgets and clear work plans to improve the likelihood of securing funding.

5. CONCLUSIONS

The activities carried out during the period M12-M24 of the **Digital European Innovation Hub (EDIH) Madrid Region** project under **WP5** demonstrate significant progress in supporting the digital transformation of SMEs within the national service sectors. The services delivered reflect a comprehensive approach to addressing the key challenges faced by these organizations in their digitalization journey when looking for funding opportunities. The key aspects that contributed to the overall success of the project are the following:

- **Support for financing and investment:** The **Support to Find Investment** service addressed a crucial gap for many SMEs by offering tailored guidance in identifying national and European funding opportunities. With **243 services provided**, including support in proposal writing and connecting SMEs to consortiums for EU programs and private investors, this initiative directly contributed to increasing the chances of securing financial resources for digitalization projects, **reaching 4.7M€**.

The services provided during this period have contributed meaningfully to the digitalization of SMEs in the Madrid region. By offering targeted support and practical tools for digital transformation. The project has laid a solid foundation for long-term improvements in competitiveness and innovation capacity. The ongoing engagement with SMEs also positions the EDIH as a key player in the region's broader digitalization strategy, helping to align local efforts with national and European digital goals.
